

CHINESE TRANSLATION LAUNCHED OF THE AVIATORS' MODEL CODE OF CONDUCT

Hong Kong, June 2006 - A Chinese translation of the *Aviators' Model Code of Conduct* (AMCC) was launched today. Spearheaded by Lucy Tsui Lai-yeung, Technical Secretary of the Hong Kong Aircrew Officers Association (HKAOA), the Chinese translation presents broad guidance and recommendations to advance flight safety, airmanship and the Chinese General Aviation (GA) community, as well as to assist Chinese-speaking pilots globally. Supporting contributors to the Chinese translation included James Georgechen, Thomas Hsueh, Dr. Ying Kiang, Peter Whiting, and James Ching-ting Young. The AMCC presents a vision of excellence in General Aviation within its seven sections: (1) General Responsibilities of Aviators; (2) Passengers and People on the Surface; (3) Training and Proficiency; (4) Security; (5) Environmental Issues; (6) Use of Technology; and (7) Advancement and Promotion of General Aviation. The AMCC is a “living document,” periodically updated to reflect changes in aviation practices and the aviation environment. The Commentary addresses selected issues within the AMCC to elaborate on their meaning, provide interpretive guidance, and help determine the most effective ways to adopt the AMCC. Other translations available include Danish, French, and Spanish.
