SECUREAV RELEASES FRENCH TRANSLATION OF AVIATORS' MODEL CODE OF CONDUCT

July 2006 – SecureAv, a California organization, announces the release and immediate availability of a French translation of the *Aviators' Model Code of Conduct* (AMCC).

Spearheaded by Dominique Marais, Chief Pilot of the West Valley Flying Club, Palo Alto, California, the French translation (*Le Modèle de Code de Conduite de l'Aviateur*) presents broad guidance and recommendations to advance flight safety and responsible airmanship in the General Aviation community. The AMCC was created to assist pilots throughout the world. Danish, Chinese and Spanish versions have already been released. Supporting contributors to the French translation included Viviane Schaller and Claude Perreault, Notaire.

The Code of Conduct presents a vision of excellence in General Aviation within its seven sections: (1) General Responsibilities of Aviators; (2) Passengers and People on the Surface; (3) Training and Proficiency; (4) Security; (5) Environmental Issues; (6) Use of Technology; and (7) Advancement and Promotion of General Aviation. The AMCC is a “living document,” periodically updated to reflect changes in aviation practices and the aviation environment. Its *Commentary*, available at <http://www.secureav.com/Commentary-Index.pdf>, addresses selected issues within the AMCC to provide interpretive guidance and suggest effective ways to adopt the AMCC.
