March 11, 2013 – The AMCC’s Permanent Editorial Board held a successful and productive two-day general meeting on March 2-3 at the Aircraft Electronics Association’s (AEA) headquarters in Lee’s Summit, Missouri. Ric Peri, PEB Board Member and AEA Vice President, Government & Industry Affairs hosted the meeting. Among other matters, the project’s mission statement was revised, teaching methods and tools considered, and current drafting projects reviewed (including a *Helicopter Pilots Model Code of Conduct*). The meeting also included strategic planning, assessment and evaluation of the project’s effectiveness, and consideration of diverse flight safety topics including passenger safety/briefing, safety management systems (SMS), and promotion of the project’s work product.
