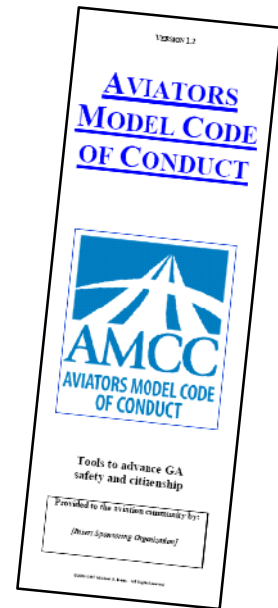


PERMANENT EDITORIAL BOARD RELEASES UPDATED AVIATORS MODEL CODE OF CONDUCT

June 22, 2007 - The Permanent Editorial Board (PEB) for the *AVIATORS MODEL CODE OF CONDUCT* (AMCC) has today released an updated version – version 1.2. This version incorporates more than two years of experience implementing the AMCC, lessons learned from developing various language translations, and valuable results of researching and drafting new AMCC commentary. AMCC version 1.1 was released in March, 2005.

To develop the updated version, the PEB solicited and obtained widespread external review and comment from diverse segments of the General Aviation (GA) community. While the underlying provisions have proven enduring, the over-all document reflects improvements to its readability and utility.



The *Aviators Model Code of Conduct* seeks to advance flight safety, airmanship, and the GA community. It is a living document, periodically updated to reflect changes in aviation practices and the aviation environment.
