Fashioned after the more-comprehensive Aviators' Model Code of Conduct, the Student Code is an introduction to the most important steps a new pilot can take to advance a safe pilot's mindset. The principles also cover pilot courtesy and the pursuit of personal improvement, so that the new pilot can quickly contribute to the aviation culture. Awareness of environmental impacts of GA flight (spanning from poor fuel sampling practices to insensitivity to the airports' neighbors) is another factor that will increase a sense of public responsibility.

If one provision in the *Student Code* sums up its spirit, it is: Pursue a rigorous, life-long course of aviation study. This encompasses flying skills, safety, security, and attitude – all essential attributes of a satisfying lifetime of flying.
