IMC Club's Library Published the "Flight Instructors Model Code Of Conduct"

Norwood, MA - IMC Club's library published the Flight Instructors Model Code of Conduct (FIMCC). Developed by a team of aviation professionals and drawing upon decades of research and experience, the Code recommends operating practices to improve the quality of instruction and the safety of operation. FIMCC is available in the IMC Club's library as well as via a link on the front page.

According to the FIMCC's authors: "Flight instructors serve as role models for the entire aviation community. The FIMCC can be a valuable tool for flight instructors at all levels and defined light sport or instrument, large flight schools or independent operators. The manner in which [instructors] teach and the example [they] set impact[s] the safety culture of aviation."

The FIMCC is a set of guidelines that is adaptable to instructor's needs. It can build and enhance not only the perception, but the reality of the instructor-student relationship as that of respected professional and client. The FIMCC was developed as a volunteer effort and is provided without charge as a public service. The Code and supporting materials can be found online or secureav.com.
