AVIATORS MODEL CODE OF CONDUCT

During EAA AirVenture Oshkosh 2007, NASAO Chairman **Travis Vallin** (Colorado) and Vice Chair **Michelle McEnany** (Iowa) met with **Michael Baum**, the developer of a Model Code of Conduct for Aviators. Michael tells us that several groups and pilot organizations have adopted the Code of Conduct. Our NASAO Executive Committee thought that the full membership might be interested in the code and perhaps adapting it for state usage or passing it along to local pilot groups.
