

NOTES FOR PROSPECTIVE IMPLEMENTERS

Thank you for considering implementing the Code of Conduct. These notes may help you adapt the Code of Conduct to your organization:

- 1. Flexibility** – The Code of Conduct has been drafted as a model code. Users are free to customize or otherwise revise the document to fit their needs. Feel free to implement the Code of Conduct in a manner that works best for your audience.

While the Code has been designed with the expectation that it will be revised as appropriate, there are underlying benefits to harmonizing your implementation with the Model, such as the ability to use effectively the [Commentary](#) as reference material.
