

NOTES FOR PROSPECTIVE IMPLEMENTERS

Thank you for considering implementation of the Code of Conduct. These notes may help you adapt the Code to accommodate your personal or organizational needs, environment, mission, skill, experience, and equipment:

1. **Flexibility** – The Code of Conduct has been drafted as a *model* code. Users are free to customize or otherwise revise the document to fit their needs. Feel free to implement the Code of Conduct in the manner that works best for your audience. There are, however, benefits to harmonizing your implementation with the Model, such as the ability to effectively use the [Commentary](#) as reference material.
