

DR. BILL RHODES JOINS PERMANENT EDITORIAL BOARD

May 2006—Bill Rhodes, Ph.D. has joined the Permanent Editorial Board (PEB) of the *Aviators Model Code of Conduct*. Dr. Rhodes, a retired Air Force officer, specializes in professional ethics. He served as head of the Philosophy Department at the Air Force Academy and as executive director of the Academy’s Leadership Development Council. He currently serves as chair of the International Society for Military Ethics and as principal, Aerworthy, LLC. Rhodes brings both academic and practical perspective to the Board. He has conducted extensive research in ethical development, professional identity, and cultural change. He’s developed and taught numerous courses at the college level, crafted institutional strategic initiatives, and spoken widely on professional development, teaching ethics, and assessment. He learned to fly in high school, and owns a Cessna 210.

The PEB provides editorial oversight and stewardship of the *Aviators’ Model Code of Conduct* (AMCC), the *Student Pilots’ Model Code of Conduct*, and the *Seaplane Pilots’ Model Code of Conduct* and supporting materials (collectively, “the Codes”). The Codes provide broad guidance for both pilots and flight students to advance airmanship, flight safety, and the vibrancy of the aviation community. The Codes are “living documents,” intended to be revised periodically as warranted by changing aviation practices and the aviation environment.
