The Permanent Editorial Board (PEB) provides editorial oversight and stewardship of the *Aviators’ Model Code of Conduct* (Code of Conduct), various implementations of the AMCC (including the *Glider Aviators*, *Light Sport Aviators*, *Seaplane Pilots*, and *Student Pilots Model Code of Conduct*), and supporting materials—available at <www.secureav.com>. The Code of Conduct provides tools to advance GA safety and citizenship.

The Code of Conduct is a living document intended to be updated periodically to reflect changes in aviation practices and the aviation environment. The Code of Conduct is “organizationally neutral”—neither owned nor controlled by any particular aviation organization. This neutrality both advances its acceptability and ensures that the viewpoints of diverse organizations are considered. Indeed, such neutrality and objectivity have been essential to the success of the project and must be continually fostered to ensure their value to the broadest reaches of the GA community.
