






## THE PERMANENT EDITORIAL BOARD

The Permanent Editorial Board (PEB) provides editorial oversight and stewardship of the *Aviators Model Code of Conduct* (Code of Conduct), various implementations of the Code of Conduct, and supporting materials, available at <[www.secureav.com](http://www.secureav.com)>. The Code of Conduct provides tools advancing GA safety and citizenship.

The Code of Conduct is a living document intended to be updated periodically to reflect changes in aviation practices and the aviation environment. “Organizationally neutral,” the Code of Conduct is neither owned nor controlled by any particular aviation organization. This neutrality both advances its acceptability and ensures that the viewpoints of diverse organizations are considered.
