

AMCC COMMENTARY LAUNCHED

May 2005 – Portions of the Commentary to the AVIATORS' MODEL CODE OF CONDUCT (AMCC) have been launched. The Commentary is intended primarily for implementers, policy administrators, and aviation association management. It elaborates on selected issues within the AMCC to provide interpretive guidance and help AMCC adopters determine the most effective ways to implement the document. It is highly annotated and provides numerous secondary source materials to support the AMCC's positions and to provide further information.

The launched portions of the Commentary address:

- *AMCC VI.c – Transponders*: the use of transponders and flight following, *available at* < <http://www.secureav.com/Comment-AMCC-VI.c-Transponders.pdf> >.

Future published portions of the Commentary will address the remaining provisions of the AMCC.
