
UKRAINIAN VERSION RELEASED OF THE AVIATORS MODEL CODE OF CONDUCT

October 21, 2022 - A Ukrainian translation of the *Aviators Model Code of Conduct* (AMCC) Version 3.0 was released today. Spearheaded by Oleksandr Krotenko, an MBA student at UC Berkeley, the Ukrainian translation presents broad guidance and recommendations to advance flight safety, airmanship and the aviation community, as

well as to assist Ukrainian-speaking pilots globally. Viktor Krotenko, a civil aviation engineer, assisted in the translation. The translation is available at secureav.com/AMCC-Translations.html.

Developed by the Aviators Code Initiative (ACI) Permanent Editorial Board, a team of aviation professionals, and drawing upon decades of research and experience, AMCC presents a vision of excellence in aviation within its seven sections: (1) General



Responsibilities of Aviators; (2) Passengers and People on the Surface; (3) Training and Proficiency; (4) Security; (5) Environmental Issues; (6) Use of Technology; and (7) Advancement and Promotion of Aviation. The AMCC is a "living document," updated periodically to reflect changes in aviation practices and the aviation environment. There are more than ten other AMCC language translations offered, as well as translations of other ACI Codes of Conduct.
